Dear Cooperative Light & Power Member:

Cooperative Light & Power (CLP) has contracted Central Applicators, Inc. to perform mechanical brush mowing and tree clearing operations along the power line right-of-way (ROW) from the intersection of Highway 44 and the Rossini Road up to Hugo's Bar starting on or about January 18, 2021 and going through March. These dates are estimates; actual dates subject to change. Check our website for the latest updates.

Trees and woody brush will be mowed out of the ROW corridors and trees along the edge may be trimmed back to provide sufficient clearance from the conductors. During the operations, any weak, leaning or diseased trees along the edge of the ROW will also be removed to help mitigate any potential future outages they may cause.

This scheduled maintenance will help reduce costs and improve the reliability of the power line's electrical service. In addition, having a clear powerline right-of-way provides CLP personnel and contractors with better accessibility, allowing them to respond to storm events or perform maintenance activities in a more timely and safe manner for both them as well as the member public at large.
