

## RE: Notification of Right of Way Vegetation Management - January 2024

Members:

Cooperative Light and Power has a vegetation management contractor work on overhead primary powerline right of ways in the service area. The contractor will be mechanically removing right of way vegetation and hazard trees north of Two Harbors, Murphy City to Isabella, and in the Larsmont and Knife River areas. Mechanical right of way management may include hand cutting, trimming, brush mowing, and mulching. Members and/or property owners will be notified by the Utility Forester before work begins if there will be right of way impacts on their property.

The objective of this work is to proactively remove woody vegetation growing within the right of way to prevent future line interference, and maintain the required width of the right of way. By proactively controlling and reducing vegetation height, we can dramatically reduce power outages in our service area.
