ALONG HIGHWAY 61, TWO HARBORS TO GOOSEBERRY FALLS

As part of our vegetation management and wildfire mitigation efforts, members may begin to see YTS tree crews working along Highway 61 starting **Monday, June 1**.



Work will begin near County Highway 3 in Two Harbors and will continue north along Highway 61 toward Gooseberry Falls State Park.



CLP's Wildfire mitigation plan focuses on protecting members and the community by proactively reducing wildfire risk through vegetation management, infrastructure monitoring, and effective response planning. Clear communication and community collaboration help strengthen preparedness and reduce wildfire threats.



Crews will use both manual and mechanical equipment to trim and remove vegetation along select power line right-of-ways. Every effort will be made to minimize disturbance while work is completed in phases throughout the project area.
